In the New Testament, PAUL spoke often of Christ’s return. PETER and of course JOHN wrote of seeing Him FACE to FACE.

God is OMNISCIENT.

Isaiah 41, 44, 45, 46, and others describe Israel’s propensity for IDOLATRY.

God is a SPEAKING God.

God is a REVEALING God.

God knows the FUTURE because God CONTROLS the future.

God alone knows the future and therefore has the exclusive right to be WORSHIPPED.

God PROTECTS the remnant that belongs to Him.

Antichrist’s reign of terror lasts 3 1/2 years. The purpose is JUDGING Jewish unbelievers and MANIFESTING true believers.

144,000 Jews (12,000 from each tribe) come to faith in Christ and PREACH the Gospel.

People will be saved from EVERY tongue, EVERY tribe, EVERY people and EVERY nation!
